

RULES FOR THE 2015-2016 MIGUEL HERNÁNDEZ UNIVERSITY OF ELCHE PEPE ANDREU RADIO AWARD FOR JOURNALISM

The Pepe Andreu Radio Award for journalism, created in 2008 by the Miguel Hernández University of Elche (UMH) and the Alicante Press Association (APA), is intended to stimulate the work of radio professionals.

RULES:

- 1. All radio programs broadcast by national and international broadcasters or broadcasting networks, covering the realms of culture, science, athletics, and education, and between 5 and 30 minutes in length, are eligible to enter this contest.
- 2. Such programs must have been broadcast between **January 1, 2015 and December 31, 2016**. To choose the winner, various aspects, such as creativity, originality, and production, will be evaluated.
- 3. Entities that are legally constituted and authorized to either broadcast or to perform broadcasting functions, in addition to professionals in general, may present their candidates for the Miguel Hernández University of Elche Pepe Andreu Radio Award. Likewise, candidates presented by other means of communication and by other persons with recognized prestige within the field of communication will also be accepted.
- 4. To be eligible for the award, proposals must be sent before September 30, 2017 by either registered mail or by presenting them to the UMH General Registry or any of its auxiliary registries, and which include the following: two CD copies of the program broadcast in .mp3, .wav, or .mp2 formats, along with certification by the director of the broadcaster indicating the day, time, broadcasting frequency, and the information of the author/s responsible for the work, in addition to Annex I, which is attached to the rules of this award, duly completed, to the following address:

Entries received outside this period will not be accepted. Programs broadcast in neither of the two official languages of the Valencian Community (Spanish and Valencian) must be accompanied by the corresponding translation and **Annex II** (sworn declaration), duly completed.

- 5. All kinds of complementary information that is deemed important, e.g., reports, professional curriculum, audience studies, press dossiers, etc., may also be provided.
- 6. A single prize of **3,000 euros** will be awarded, which will be provided by the **Miguel Hernández University of Elche**.
- 7. The contest judges, comprised of four persons designated by the Miguel Hernández University of Elche and four media professionals designated by the Alicante Press Association, and presided over by the UMH Rector or another person that the Rector delegates, will announce their decision in November 2017. The contest winner will be notified personally, and the result will also be published on the UMH webpage (www.umh.es).
- 8. The award presentation will take place in a public ceremony to be held in **November 2017 in Elche**.
- 9. The Miguel Hernández University of Elche may make a preliminary selection of the work presented. Furthermore, the judges may propose radio work that they consider may be susceptible to winning. The participants, by merely entering the contest, fully accept the contest rules.



- 10. **The Miguel Hernández University of Elche** may utilize the winning program in not-for-profit campaigns without it providing the right to any compensation for its participants.
- 11. The prize may be declared **void**, and if so, such decision by the judges will be final.
- 12. The judges have full authority for interpreting these rules.
