Véronique Bellon-Maurel es directora de #DigitAg, I Instituto Convergencias en Agricultura Digital, en Montpellier, Francia.

Ms Véronique Bellon-Maurel is an agricultural engineer initially specialized in optical sensors for plants, agricultural products and soil, and then evolving towards precision agriculture and digital agriculture. She works at INRAE, one of the largest research institutes on agriculture, food and environment in the world, where she is deputy-head of the Mathnum departement (math, digital and computer science). She is currently the director of #DigitAg, the digital agriculture convergence laboratory, a 500 staff-members multidisciplinary institute devoted to digital agriculture in France. #DigitAg aims at developing a responsible digital agriculture, focusing both on production improvement issues (phenotyping, precision agriculture) and on digitally-enabled inclusiveness of farmers (in value chains, in territories). This institute also host higher education programs. In parallel, She is also the coordinator of Occitanum, a Living-Lab which boosts open innovation in digital technologies dedicated to agroecological transition and local food supply. She is member of the French Academy of Technology.
